- We set up collection points for the books at both Nakumatts, in town and at the mega cit, and at Uchumi supermarkets

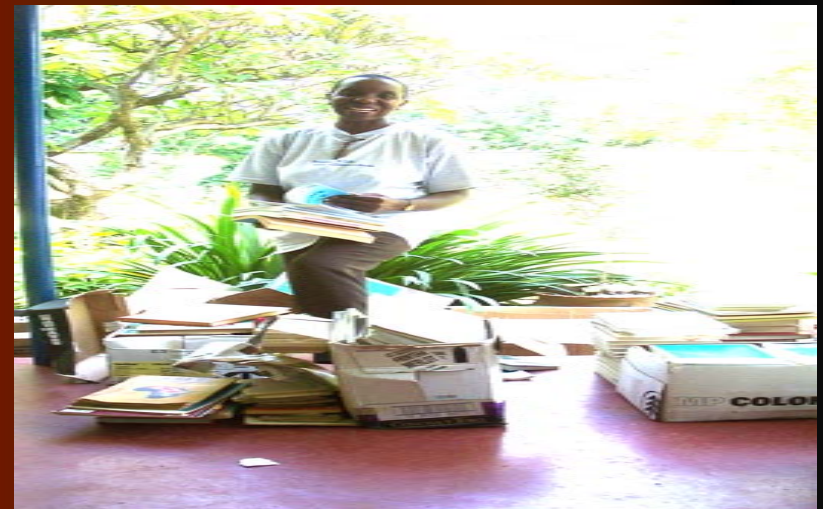


SORTING OF BOOKS
